Background

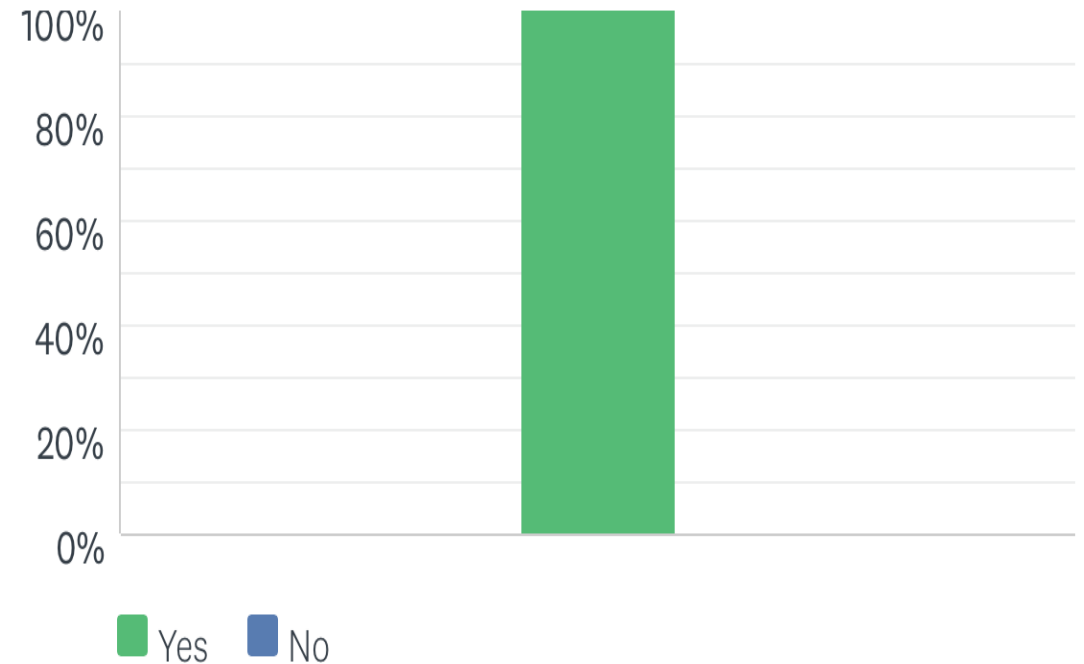
All our pupils returned to full time education in September 2020.

Using Survey Monkey - we asked 5 key questions of our families around how they were feeling about a return to school through the continuing global pandemic.

We also wanted to know how well families had felt supported by school's blended approach to home learning during the previous term's national lockdown.

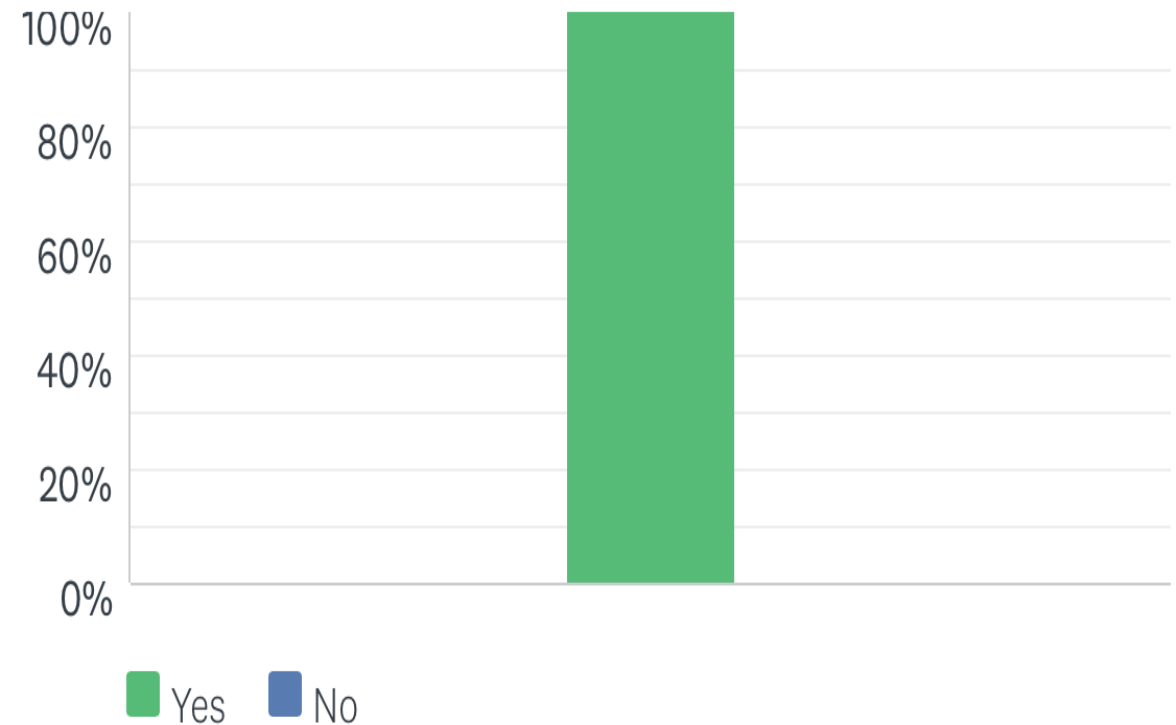
Are you happy with the Covid-19 measures school has introduced?

100% of respondents were happy with school's Covid safety measures.



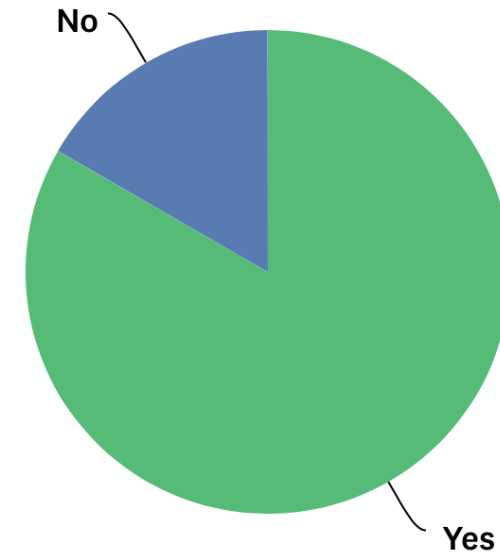
Do you feel your child has had a positive return to school?

100% of respondents said their child had a positive return to school.



Do you feel you have had enough information from school about Covid-19?

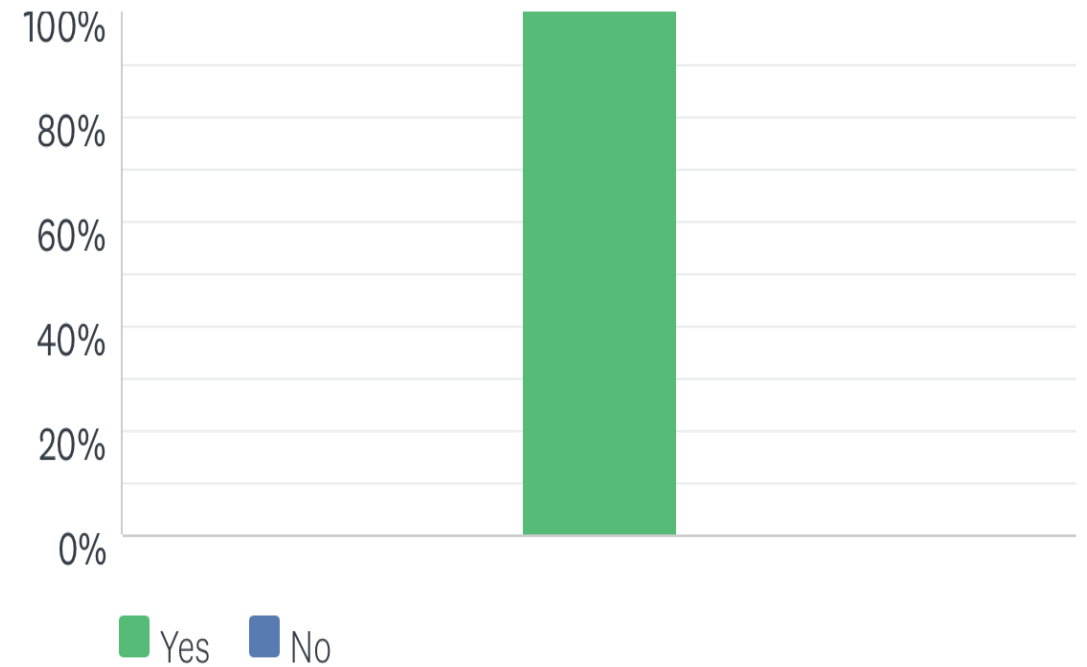
16% of respondents felt they needed more information.



School contacted this parent to chat and ask what else school could do to help. The conversation with mum helped to explain exactly how we were working to keep children safe in school. We were also able to signpost mum to additional links and resources on the web site and School Dojo.

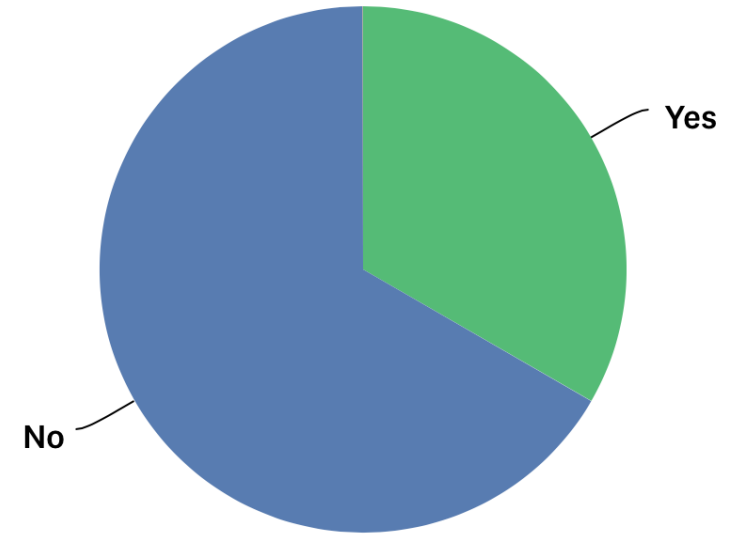
Are you happy with the way school has supported home learning?

100% of respondents were happy with the blended approach to home learning.



Are there any other concerns around school and Covid-19?

33% of respondents said yes they had concerns



School contacted these parents to chat about their concerns. Conversations were around school transport and risk of transmission. School was able to talk through arrangements for arrival at school and the hand/hygiene washing procedures in place to help minimise risk. These conversations helped by giving families a chance to talk through their worries. It also gave school an opportunity to review hygiene procedures to ensure they were rigorous.
