Background

The EU Settlement Scheme has been set up to provide immigration status to those who need it as the UK leaves the EU.

The UK's departure from the EU means that EEA citizens, and their family members, will no longer be able to rely on the right of free movement and will need to obtain immigration status to demonstrate their right to remain in the UK.

It means that they can continue to be eligible for:

Public services, such as healthcare and schools;

Public funds and pensions;

British citizenship, if they meet the requirements and want to apply.

The Scheme opened on 30 March 2019 and **applications must be made by June 2021.**

It is free to make applications to the Scheme.
