

Nominated Governor – Sports Premium Terms of Reference (2024-2025)

1. The Sports Premium Nominated Governor is appointed by the Full Governing Body.
2. The Sports Premium Nominated Governor is responsible for ensuring that the PE and Sports Premium is used effectively by the School. This is so the Governing Body can meet its responsibilities.
3. The key contact for the Sports Premium Nominated Governor will be the Headteacher.
4. The key responsibilities of the Sports Premium Nominated Governor are as follows:
 - To be familiar with the DfE Guidance on PE and Sports Premium.
 - Keep the Governing Body informed about changes to the DfE Guidance on PE and Sports Premium.
 - Ensure that the PE and Sports Premium is being used effectively by the School.
 - Check that the required information has been published on the School Web Site.
 - To provide feedback to the Governing Body on a Termly basis, normally at the Full Governing Body Meeting, on activities delivered using PE and Sports Premium and the impact that such activities have had on Pupil's participation and attainment.
 - To attend Governor Training Sessions to improve their effectiveness as the Sports Premium Nominated Governor.
 - To represent the Governing Body on matters related to PE and Sports Premium.
5. It should be noted that it is the role of the Sports Premium Nominated Governor is to ensure that the use of PE and Sports Premium funding supports the strategic direction set by the Governing Body. The Headteacher is responsible for operational matters and as such the Sports Premium Nominated Governor should not become involved with issues that are the responsibility of the Headteacher.
6. These Terms of Reference will be reviewed annually and be approved at the Full Governing Body Meeting held in the Autumn Term of the Academic Year.
